7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 34:1(A)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§1. Continuation; qualifications; appointments; terms; vacancies
10	A. Membership; qualifications; vacancies.
11	* * *
12	(3) All members shall be experienced in the commerce or industry, or both,
13	of the port area, and shall otherwise possess the qualifications prescribed by law.
14	Notwithstanding any prohibition contained in Part II of Chapter 15 of Title 42 of the
15	Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, individuals employed in the maritime industry
16	may serve as members hereunder a member appointed prior to August 1, 2018,
17	employed in the maritime industry may serve as a member as provided in this
18	Paragraph. The provisions of Title 42 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950
19	in effect on the date of the appointment of a member appointed prior to
20	August 1, 2018, shall apply to that member for the term of that member. The
21	present members appointed prior to August 1, 2018, seven in number, shall
22	continue to serve on the board for the duration of their respective terms, and shall

1950 in effect on the date of that member's appointment. A member appointed

on or after August 1, 2018, employed in the maritime industry may serve as a

6	D. No appointed member of any board or commission, except as otherwise
7	provided in R.S. 42: 1120.1 or 1120.4, shall participate or be interested in any
8	transaction involving the agency when a violation of this Part would result.

10	§1120.4. Recusal from voting; certain appointed members of boards and
11	commissions
12	A. Except for any member of a board or commission specifically provided
13	for in R.S. 42:1120.1, if If any appointed member of a board or commission in the
14	discharge of a duty or responsibility of his office or position, would be required to
15	vote on a matter which vote would be a violation of R.S. 42:1112, he shall recuse
16	himself from voting.

18	Section 3. R.S. 42:1120.1 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
