Legislative report requirements; notification requirements 15 A.(1) Each board or commission authorized to issue a license, permit, 16 or certificate under this Title shall submit quarterly reports to the appropriate 17 legislative oversight committees and to the House Committee on House and 18 Governmental Affairs and the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs. The reports required by this Subsection shall contain: 19

20 (a) The number of complaints received regarding board actions or 21 procedures. 22

(b) A summary of each such complaint and the disposition of each complaint.

(2) If any of the information required to be submitted pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection contains confidential, personally identifiable, or otherwise sensitive information, the board or commission shall clearly mark such information as confidential, personally identifiable, or sensitive information and the legislative committees, members, and employees having access to the identified information shall not publicly disclose the information and shall protect the information from unauthorized use and disclosure.

B.(1) Each board or commission authorized to issue a license, permit, or 32 certificate under this Title shall give notice to each applicant and licensee in or 33 with each correspondence from the board or commission that the applicant or 34 licensee may submit complaints about actions or procedures of the board or 35 commission to the board or commission or directly to the House Committee on 36 House and Governmental Affairs and the Senate Committee on Senate and **Governmental Affairs.**
