## **DIGEST**

<u>Present law</u> provides that any district court which is empowered to hear civil matters shall have jurisdiction over proceedings seeking protections available in cases dealing with stalking and cyberstalking.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that in jurisdictions that have a municipal and traffic court, that court shall have sole jurisdiction over proceedings pursuant to the <u>present law</u> Protection from Stalking Act, in the event a law enforcement officer issues a summons or citation.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Judiciary</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Provide municipal and traffic courts with sole jurisdiction over matters pursuant to the Protection from Stalking Act when a law enforcement officer has issued a summons or citation.

1. Deletes exception to <u>present law</u> relative to jurisdictions that have a municipal and traffic court under certain circumstances.
