<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a report to the legislature relative to offenders released for "good time" as well a report to the legislature relative to offenders released on parole on or before August 1, 2018, and no later than August first of each year. <u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the release of any information relative to juvenile offenders pursuant to a public records request or otherwise deemed confidential by law and shall be redacted from the reports.
