FAMILY VIOLENCE: Provides relative to actions filed under the Protection from Stalking Act

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

- 1. Removes <u>proposed</u> language giving sole jurisdiction to municipal and traffic courts over proceedings pursuant to the Protection from Stalking Act.
- 2. Reinstates <u>present law</u> granting any district court in Louisiana with jurisdiction over proceedings pursuant to the Protection from Stalking Act.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides that any district court which is empowered to hear civil matters shall have jurisdiction over proceedings seeking protections available in cases dealing with stalking and cyberstalking.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and also provides that in jurisdictions with a municipal and traffic court, that court shall have jurisdiction over proceedings pursuant to the <u>present law</u> Protection from Stalking Act, in the event a law enforcement officer issues a summons or citation.
