3 to the citizens of Louisiana impacted by the historic flooding of Louisiana in 2016.

4 WHEREAS, after organizing efforts to rescue citizens in Texas after Hurricane
5 Harvey, Todd Terrell decided to form the United Cajun Navy; and

6 WHEREAS, the United Cajun Navy was founded upon the principles that unity is
7 strength and neighbors are proud to help out neighbors during times of need; and

8 WHEREAS, in following these principles, Mr. Terrell and the United Cajun Navy
9 volunteers have assisted citizens of Louisiana impacted by the historic flooding of Louisiana
10 in 2016 by programs such as "Come Home for Christmas" and the distribution and
11 installation of free smoke alarms; and

12 WHEREAS, "Come Home for Christmas" was a program run by United Cajun Navy
13 and Family First Recovery Group with the purpose of getting as many people back in their
14 once-flooded homes prior to Christmas 2017; and

15 WHEREAS, as of December 17, 2017, more than one hundred people signed up and
16 at least a dozen were home just in time for Christmas 2017; and

17 WHEREAS, in response to a spike in fire-related accidents in early January 2018,
