HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE EN NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to pharmacy benefit managers. (8/1/18)

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<u>Present law</u> requires pharmacy benefit managers to be licensed by Louisiana Department of Insurance (LDI). <u>Proposed law</u> requires LDI to have a dedicated location on their website to publish pharmacy benefit manager information, including the formulary and timely notification of formulary changes by each licensed pharmacy benefit manager. <u>Proposed law</u> requires pharmacy benefit managers beginning on 6/1/20 to issue an annual transparency report that discloses aggregate data on rebates received from drug manufacturers, administrative fees, and aggregate rebates received that did not pass through to the health benefit plan or insurer. <u>Proposed law</u> requires LDI to publish the transparency report within sixty days of receipt from the pharmacy benefit manager. <u>Proposed law</u> requires a pharmaceutical drug manufacturer to notify the commissioner of insurance by electronic mail of an increase in wholesale acquisition cost of fifty percent or greater for a drug with a wholesale acquisition cost of one hundred dollars or more for a thirty-day supply not more than 30 days after the price increase. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for an exception to the Public Records Law.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed legislation will have no impact to the Louisiana Department of Insurance (LDI) to publish information on its website. Any technical changes to LDI's website necessary to comply with this measure are anticipated to be performed with the LDI's current maintenance contract. This measure will require pharmacy benefit managers to disclose to LDI aggregate data concerning rebates received from drug manufacturers, administrative fees, and an increase in wholesale acquisition cost of fifty percent or greater for a drug with a wholesale acquisition cost of one hundred dollars or more.
