| 12 | staff appointee eligibility to serve on the board of commissioners; to provide for |
| 13 | permissible contract and subcontract practices by licensed physicians nominated or |
| 14 | appointed to serve on the board of commissioners; to provide for a per diem and |
| 15 | maximum number of meetings per month increase for the board of commission |
| 16 | members; and to provide for related matters. |
