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#### **ENROLLED**

1	<b>D.</b> The executive branch agency tasked with producing the report shall,
2	not later than the January first immediately preceding the expiration date,
3	notify the committees of the pending expiration of the mandate via electronic
4	mail. The notification shall include at a minimum a citation of the original
5	mandate requiring the report, a copy of the most recent report, and an estimate
6	of the agency resources including costs expended in producing the report.
7	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018; if vetoed by the governor
8	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
9	2018, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
