ACT 343 (SB 7) 2018 Regular Session Peacock

<u>Prior law</u>, relative to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System (MPERS), provides for a definition of "average final compensation".

<u>New law</u> provides for specificity of language relative to the definition of average final compensation.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that any disability retiree who is blinded or who loses the total use of a limb solely as a result of injuries sustained on or after July 1, 2003, in the performance of his official duties, and whose condition is certified by the State Medical Disability Board, shall receive a benefit equal to his final average compensation.

<u>New law</u> retains these provisions but includes a disability retiree who suffers a traumatic physical injury causing permanent damage to the brain or spinal cord as a result of injuries sustained on or after July 1, 2003, in the performance of his official duties, and whose condition is certified by the State Medical Disability Board, shall receive a benefit equal to his final average compensation.
