6	Rouge on Saturday, February 10, 2018, at the age of eighty-two; and
7	WHEREAS, Mr. Clark graduated from Baton Rouge High in 1953 and earned a
8	bachelor's degree in business administration from Louisiana State University in 1958; and
9	WHEREAS, he honorably served his country as a 2nd Lieutenant in the Army
10	Medical Service Corps; and
11	WHEREAS, Frank was stationed at Ft. Sam Houston, which is where he met his
12	wife, 2nd Lieutenant Joan Cecile Wittenauer, an army nurse; the two had three children who
13	live on to cherish his memory; and
14	WHEREAS, Mr. Clark returned to Baton Rouge where he was a banker for over
15	forty years, starting at Fidelity Bank in 1953 and retiring from Regions Bank in 2000; and
16	WHEREAS, Mr. Clark was a founding member of St. Jude the Apostle Catholic
17	Church where he served as a Eucharistic minister and a fair worker and was a member of a
18	Bible study group; and
19	WHEREAS, Mr. Clark enjoyed finding and restoring old clocks, loved to read, and
20	taught himself about computers after retirement; he enjoyed socializing with the Out to
21	Lunch Bunch who frequented local restaurants; and
