Prior law provided for the definition of "child" in the La. Children's Code.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that, after June 30, 2018, "child" means any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after July 1, 2018, when the act is not a crime of violence and occurs before the person attains 18 years of age.

<u>New law</u> revises <u>prior law</u> and provides that beginning March 1, 2019, "child" means any person under the age of 21, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act on or after March 1, 2019, when the act is not a crime of violence and occurs before the person attains 18 years of age.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 1, 2018).
