6	Section 1. R.S. 42:66(E) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§66. Exemptions
8	* * *
9	E. Nothing in this Part shall be construed to prohibit a certified public
10	accountant who is a member of a school board in any parish having a population of
11	less than fifty-thousand according to the latest federal decennial census from holding
12	employment with a sheriff to provide financial or accounting services.
13	* * *
14	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
15	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
16	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
17	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
18	effective on the day following such approval.
