<u>Existing law</u> requires the concurrence of the coroner for the filing of a petition for continuing tutorship. New law requires the coroner's concurrence to be written.

<u>Existing law</u> provides for restrictions on legal capacity in certain circumstances and exceptions to those restrictions. <u>Prior law</u> included an exception to the restriction on legal capacity for a person with intellectual disabilities over the age of eighteen, granting such person the legal capacity of a minor operating under emancipation conferring the power of administration. New law repeals prior law.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that a decree restricting legal capacity may be contested in court and provides for the standard of proof. <u>New law</u> replaces the standard of proof with good cause.

Effective August 1, 2018.
