

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 198 (HB 184)**

**2018 Regular Session**

**Leger**

Existing law provides that a person convicted of a DWI violation who was subjected to a blood, breath, or urine analysis for alcohol or any controlled dangerous substance shall be assessed certain costs. Prior law provided for an additional \$75 as special costs to be paid as follows:

- (1) \$25 to the governing authority owning the instrument used to perform the analysis.
- (2) \$50 to the governing authority whose agency performed the analysis.

New law increases the special costs from \$75 to \$125, with \$75 paid to the governing authority owning the instrument.

Effective August 1, 2018.
