Existing law authorizes the clerk of any district court to contract for group insurance for the clerk of court, employees, and dependants of the clerk or the clerk's employees. Further provides that the clerk or any clerk's employee that retires under the clerk of court retirement program may elect to continue insurance coverage under the program and that the cost may be paid in the same manner as if he were still employed by the clerk of court, if employed by the clerk of court and a member of the La. Clerks' of Court Retirement and Relief Fund for at least 12 years prior to retirement.

<u>New law</u> requires the Acadia Parish clerk of court to pay the full amount of all insurance premiums for all retirees employed with the Acadia Parish clerk of court's office for at least 20 years and who are at least 55 years of age.

Effective August 1, 2018.
