## ACT 503 (HB 292) 2018 Regular Session

<u>New law</u> requires the court to allow a witness who is either under 18 years of age or who has a developmental disability to have a facility dog, if available, accompany them while testifying in court.

<u>New law</u> authorizes the court to allow the use of facility dogs in cases involving all other witnesses.

<u>New law</u> requires notice to the court and provides for jury instructions regarding the role of the facility dog.

<u>New law</u> defines "facility dog" as a dog that is certified and a graduate of an assistance dog organization that is accredited and is specially trained to provide emotional support to witnesses testifying in judicial proceedings without causing a distraction during the proceedings.

Effective August 1, 2018.
