Existing law prohibits any manufacturer, distributor, retailer, or other person from knowingly selling or distributing any tobacco product, alternative nicotine product, or vapor product to a person under the age of 18.

Existing law further requires a sign to be displayed at the point of purchase, in not less than 30-point type, that reads "LOUISIANA LAW PROHIBITS THE SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALTERNATIVE NICOTINE PRODUCTS, OR VAPOR PRODUCTS TO PERSONS UNDER AGE 18".

<u>Existing law</u> prohibits a vending machine operator from placing in use a vending machine to vend any tobacco product, alternative nicotine product, or vapor product automatically, unless the machine displays a sign or sticker in not less than 22-point type on the front of the machine stating, "LOUISIANA LAW PROHIBITS THE SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, ALTERNATIVE NICOTINE PRODUCTS, OR VAPOR PRODUCTS TO PERSONS UNDER AGE 18".

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further requires the sign displayed at the point of purchase and on the vending machine to include a notice that displays the telephone number for the Louisiana Tobacco Quitline (1-800-QUIT-NOW) and the website for the Louisiana Tobacco Quitline (www.quitwithusla.org), as determined by the state department of health.

<u>New law</u> makes technical changes to references in <u>existing law</u> to the United States Code.

Effective November 1, 2018.
