ACT 255 (HB 17)

Carpenter

Existing law allows a member of the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System (ROVERS) who ceases to be an employee, except by death or retirement, to withdraw the amount of the accumulated contributions standing to his credit. Existing law further allows a former member who withdrew his contributions and who returns to membership in the system to repay the amount he withdrew, plus interest, in exchange for credit for the service he forfeited at the time he withdrew. Prior law allowed for such repayment to be made only after remaining a contributing member for four years. New law allows for such repayment immediately upon return to membership in the system.

Effective July 1, 2018.
