Prior law prohibited an insurance producer from employing or associating with the producer's business, in any manner, any person engaged in the business of insurance who has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this state or any other state, the United States, or any foreign country.

New law retains prior law but permits the commissioner of insurance to grant or deny consent or a waiver in his discretion to authorize the employment of the person convicted of a felony.

Effective August 1, 2018.
