3	Program; to provide for a qualified event or qualified major event; to provide for
4	National Collegiate Athletic Association conferences and conventions; and to

6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. $51:2365.1(A)(5)$ is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Abstract: Adds any National Collegiate Athletic Association conference or convention to the definition of a "qualified event" or "qualified major event" relative to the Major Events Incentive Program.

Present law defines a "qualified event" or "qualified major event" as a National Football League Super Bowl, a National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Final Four tournament game, the National Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, an NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision postseason playoff or championship game, a college tournament or championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee (USOC), an Olympic activity including a Junior or Senior activity, training program, or feeder program sanctioned by the USOC's Community Olympic Development Program, a mixed martial arts championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Bassmasters Classic, a National Motorsports race, the Red Bull Signature Series, an NCAA football kickoff game, a national championship or Olympic trials of an amateur or professional sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the sport, the United States Bowling Congress Tournament, the WWE WrestleMania, the Bayou Classic, the Essence Festival, the Zurich Classic, a national military event, or a national political convention of the Republican National Committee or of the Democratic National Committee.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds "any NCAA conference or convention" to the definition.
