**Abstract:** Expands the list of law enforcement officers whose family members can purchase their duty firearm, and eliminates the requirement that the officer must be killed in the line of duty.

<u>Present law</u> allows the immediate family members of the following law enforcement officers the right to purchase the officer's firearm when the officer was killed in the line of duty:

- (1) All sheriffs and deputy sheriffs in the state employed on a full-time basis.
- (2) All members of the state police.
- (3) All municipal police officers employed on a full-time basis.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands the list of law enforcement officers to include university and college police officers at state universities and colleges. <u>Proposed law</u> also eliminates the requirement that the officer be killed in the line of duty in order for the immediate family member to be able to purchase the firearm.
