Repeals the Washington Parish Reservoir District and authorizes the donation of any remaining property and excess funds to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism in support of the Bogue Chitto State Park. (8/1/19)

<u>Present law</u> creates a recreation and water conservation and reservoir district as a political subdivision known as the "Washington Parish Reservoir District" for the purpose of creating, maintaining, and operating a single reservoir in Washington Parish. <u>Present law</u> provides for a board of commissioners and specifies the board's duties and responsibilities. <u>Present law</u> transfers the Washington Parish Reservoir District to the Department of Transportation and Development. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u> with regard to the Washington Parish Reservoir District.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the donation of any immovable or movable property and any funds to the Secretary of the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism (CRT) in support of the Bogue Chitto State Park for expanding recreation. <u>Proposed law</u> directs the Secretary of CRT to conduct a town hall meeting no later than August 1, 2020, in Washington Parish with the legislative delegation for Washington Parish to determine the best options for expansion of recreation for Washington Parish at Bogue Chitto State Park.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure is indeterminable. Proposed law will transfer any immovable or movable property and any funds that remain from the Washington Parish Reservoir District (WPRD) to the Secretary of the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism (CRT) in support of the Bogue Chitto State Park for expanding recreation.

The Secretary of CRT is directed to conduct a town hall meeting no later than August 1, 2020, to determine the best options for expanding recreation for Washington Parish at Bogue Chitto State Park. To the extent the Secretary develops plans to support the expansion of recreation at Bogue Chitto State Park, CRT will realize an expenditure of existing fund balances. As these plans are yet to be decided, the amounts and fiscal year impacts are unknown. Expenditures are anticipated from SGF and General Obligation Bond balances in prior year capital outlay appropriations. Until plans are finalized, direct impacts to CRT operating expenses are unknown and speculative. However, to the extent the assets and property donated to Bogue Chitto State Park may expand the operational footprint of the Office of State Parks, the department may incur additional expenditures out of SGF or statutory dedications that would require legislative appropriation.

NOTE: The Louisiana Legislative Auditor issued a report on August 23, 2017, that reported a remaining balance of approximately \$817,000 out of capital outlay and SGF direct appropriations of \$3,025,000 between 2002 and 2007 to WPRD. The LFO has received unconfirmed reports that a remaining balance of approximately \$700,000 exists, against which there are reportedly some nominal outstanding encumbrances associated with WPRD expenditures. The LFO will update future fiscal notes as additional information becomes available regarding the remaining balance and outstanding obligations associated with WPRD.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.

NOTE: To the extent a remaining balance of unspent funds associated with WPRD exists, <u>proposed law</u> directs that the funds be donated to the Secretary of the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism (CRT) to support Bogue Chitto State Park for expanding recreation. The current available balance is anticipated to be approximately \$700,000, against which there are reportedly some nominal outstanding encumbrances associated with WPRD expenditures.

The LFO will update future fiscal notes as additional information becomes available regarding the available balance to be transferred to CRT.
