22 provided all required reports have been timely submitted to the secretary verifying
23 that the well did not produce an average of more than ten barrels of oil per day
24 during the entire calendar month.**25** (dd) For purposes of Subitems (bb) and (cc) of this Item, the secretary shall
26 determine the oil price upon which the exemption for a certified stripper well that
27 produces oil shall be based on July first of each year for the ensuing twelve months
28 based upon the average New York Mercantile Exchange Price per barrel of crude oil
29 per month on the close of business June thirtieth for the prior twelve months."
