HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 36

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To designate April 25, 2019, as Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

WHEREAS, professional surveying was first licensed in 1908 in the state of Louisiana when the first licenses were issued to J.B. Bice, C.P. Couvillion, and R.A. Crowson; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors was established in 1961; and

WHEREAS, each licensed professional surveyor is compelled to follow rules of professional conduct in order to protect property, to promote the welfare of the public, and to establish and maintain a high standard of integrity in the performance of his professional duties; and

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors are committed to cooperating with educational institutions to maintain high standards of education in land surveying; and

WHEREAS, licensed professional surveyors are committed to maintaining the highest levels of professional quality and to keeping abreast of the most advanced technological developments in the field, including utilizing global positioning, mapping, and spatial referencing while seeking to provide state-of-the-art surveying services to the citizens of Louisiana.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors and its members across the state for their significant contributions in service to the citizens of Louisiana.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate April 25, 2019, as Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors Day at the Louisiana State Capitol.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the president of the Louisiana Society of Professional Surveyors.
