SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates April 30, 2019, as Tourism Day at the state capitol

A RESOLUTION

2	To designate Tuesday, April 30, 2019, as Tourism Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, 2017 was a record-breaking year for tourism in this state, with more
4	than 47 million people visiting Louisiana and spending a total of \$17.5 billion; and
5	WHEREAS, 2017 visitor expenditures resulted in \$1.8 billion in state tax revenue;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, the revenue generated from domestic and international visitors
8	represents a remarkable 40-to-1 return on investment of state funding of the Louisiana office
9	of tourism; and
10	WHEREAS, tourism employment ranked fourth in the number of jobs created in
11	2017, and travel spending supports 236,000 jobs in Louisiana; and
12	WHEREAS, no state general funds are appropriated for tourism, as tourism is funded
13	exclusively by a dedication of three one-hundredths of a cent of sales tax; and
14	WHEREAS, the funds generated by this dedication have been and continue to be
15	used by the Louisiana office of tourism to promote tourism to our state, and as a result they
16	create enormous economic impact.
17	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
18	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate Tuesday, April 30, 2019, as Tourism Day
19	at the state capitol and does hereby express appreciation and support for the fine work of the
20	Louisiana office of tourism in its mission to bring visitors to Louisiana and to provide
21	ambassadorial and financial benefits to the state.
