
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2019 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to Original Senate Bill No. 214 by Senator White

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 18, and insert:

3 **"(b) The members appointed pursuant to this Paragraph shall constitute**
4 **a local review board. The local review board shall act as a representative of its**
5 **respective parish and as a special subcommittee of the State Board of**
6 **Commerce and Industry. The members of the local review board may**
7 **participate in and vote on matters affecting that parish that are submitted to the**
8 **State Board of Commerce and Industry pursuant to Article VII, Section 21(F)**
9 **of the Constitution of Louisiana."**

10 AMENDMENT NO. 2

11 On page 3, at the end of line 1, insert "**local review board and**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 3

13 On page 3, line 2, delete "**Subcommittee**" and insert "**Such**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 3, line 5, after "**the**" and before "**subcommittee**", insert "**local review board and**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 3, line 11, delete the period at the end of the line and insert:

18 **"relative to the local review board's jurisdiction and procedure. A local review**
19 **board may adopt rules pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act as are**
20 **necessary for the administration of any such local review board and**
21 **subcommittee, which rules shall not be in conflict with the rules adopted by the**
22 **State Board of Commerce and Industry. Any rule which is in conflict with the**
23 **rules adopted by the State Board of Commerce and Industry shall be null, void,**
24 **and of no effect. The State Board of Commerce and Industry is authorized to**
25 **act as a review body to determine which local review board rules are in conflict**
26 **with rules of the State Board of Commerce and Industry for purposes of**
27 **conducting business by the board."**
