33 programs for peace officers as provided in Subsections E and F of this
34 Section:**35** (i) Domestic violence awareness training.**36** (ii) Communication with deaf or hard of hearing individuals.

1 (b) The council shall create and maintain a list of peace officers who have
2 successfully completed the domestic violence awareness training and the training on
3 communication with deaf or hard of hearing individuals."
