6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 33:2541.1(B)(1)(b) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§2541.1. Deputy chief of police; competitive appointment
10	* * *
11	B.(1) * * *
12	(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, in
13	the city of Jennings, the qualifications for the position of deputy chief of police shall
14	be not less than ten five years of full-time law enforcement experience of which not
15	less than two years shall be in the classified police service of the Jennings Municipal
16	Fire and Police Civil Service at the time of appointment as deputy chief of police.
17	* * *
18	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
19	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
20	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
