CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: Provides relative to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law

## Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Adds an additional seven substances to Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law, effective if and when the Drug Enforcement Administration of the United States classifies Mitragynine as a Schedule I Controlled Dangerous Substance.

## **Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

<u>Present law</u> provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the substances' potential for addiction and abuse.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds nine substances (including Mitragynine) to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law, the schedule to which the substances will be added is dependent upon the classification of the substances as a controlled dangerous substance by the Drug Enforcement Administration of the U.S.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the crime of unlawful distribution of products containing Mitragyna speciosa to a minor.

Proposed law repeals this provision of present law.
