AN ACT

To enact R.S. 33:1651(C), relative to the governing authority of Acadia Parish; to provide relative to the term of office of the parish secretary-treasurer; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:1651(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§1651. Election and term; location of office; removal for cause; exceptions

* * *

C. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection A of this Section, the governing authority of Acadia Parish shall elect a parish secretary-treasurer for a term of four years. The secretary-treasurer's term shall be concurrent with the term of the members of the parish governing authority. If a vacancy occurs other than by an expiration of the term, it shall be filled by appointment by the parish governing authority for the unexpired term.
