Amendments proposed by Senator Martiny to Engrossed House Bill No. 157 by Representative Stagni

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, after "32:402.1(E)(7)" insert "and (8)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, after "instructional permit;" insert "to provide an exception to ignition
5 interlock requirements for certain applicants for Class "E" temporary instructional permits;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 9, after "32:402.1(E)(7)" delete "is" and insert "and (8) are"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 3, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following:

10 "(8)(a) In the event that the person applying for the temporary instructional
11 permit has or has had his driving privileges suspended pursuant to R.S. 32:661 et
12 seq., and the person is required to have an ignition interlock as a condition of
13 reinstatement, then the temporary instructional permit may be issued for purposes
14 of operating a motor vehicle during the behind-the-wheel portion of the driver
15 education program or while administering the road skills test without an ignition
16 interlock device being required.

17 (b)(i) If the driving school instructor suspects that the person is impaired at
18 the time he presents himself for the behind-the-wheel training or the administration
19 of the road skills test, the driving school instructor shall not conduct the behind-the-
20 wheel instruction or administer the road skills test, and the driving school instructor
21 shall promptly report the incident to the office of motor vehicles.

22 (ii) The office of motor vehicles shall promulgate such rules as are necessary
23 to implement the provisions of this Subparagraph.

24 (c) Neither the driving school instructor, nor the driving school utilizing the
25 driving school instructor shall be liable in any manner to any person who is denied
26 behind-the-wheel training pursuant to Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph, except for
27 any partial refund attributable to the behind-the-wheel portion of the training or the
28 road skills test."
