16 AMENDMENT NO. 18

17 On page 11, delete lines 1 through 8 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

18 §2103. Definitions  
19 The terms "cyber threat indicator" and "defensive measure  
20 information" have the meaning ascribed to them by 6 U.S.C. §1501 et seq.

21 §2104. Sharing of cybersecurity information; public entities  
22 When sharing a cyber threat indicator or defensive measure  
23 information, each natural or juridical person or public or private entity shall  
24 receive the legal protections and privileges conveyed by the federal  
25 Cybersecurity Information Sharing Act of 2015, 6 U.S.C. §1501 et seq., and R.S.  
26 51:2106.

27 §2105. Evidence standard  
28 Sharing a cyber threat indicator or defensive measure information shall  
29 not constitute a waiver of any applicable privilege or protection provided  
30 pursuant to the Louisiana Code of Evidence.

31 §2106. Receipt of cyber threat indicators and defensive measure information;  
32 appropriate state entities  
33 A. In addition to those entities identified in 6 U.S.C. §1501(3), the  
34 following entities are authorized to receive cyber threat indicators and defensive  
35 measure information, as an appropriate state entity, through electronic mail  
36 transmission:  
37 (1) The Department of Justice, office of the attorney general, Louisiana  
38 Bureau of Investigation.  
39 (2) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state  
40 police, Louisiana State Analytical and Fusion Exchange.  
41 (3) The Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency  
42 Preparedness.

1            **B. When a natural person or private or public entity is conveying a**  
2            **cyber threat indicator or defensive measure information by electronic mail, the**  
3            **natural person or public or private entity shall indicate such by populating**  
4            **"Cyber Threat Indicator" or "Cyber Defensive Measure" in the subject line of**  
5            **the electronic mail."**

8            AMENDMENT NO. 20

9            On page 11, delete lines 13 through 21 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the  
10           following:

11           **"§2108. Reporting**  
12           **No state entity that receives cybersecurity information shared pursuant**  
13           **to the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to the reporting requirements**  
14           **of 6 U.S.C. §1508."**

18           On page 11, line 25, after "Chapter" and before the period "." insert "**provided that any**  
19           **rule promulgated does not conflict with the provisions of 6 U.S.C. §1501 et seq**"
