- 12 On page 1, between lines 7 and 8 insert the following:
- 13 "§281. Instruction in sex education

14 A. 15 (2)(a) It is the intent of the legislature that, for the purposes of this Section, 16 "sex education" shall mean the dissemination of factual biological or pathological 17 information that is related to the human reproduction system and may include the 18 study of sexually transmitted disease, pregnancy, childbirth, puberty, menstruation, 19 and menopause, as well as the dissemination of factual information about parental responsibilities under the child support laws of the state. It is the intent of the 20 legislature that "sex education" shall not include religious beliefs, practices in human 21 22 sexuality, nor the subjective moral and ethical judgments of the instructor or other 23 persons. Students shall not be tested, quizzed, or surveyed about their personal or 24 family beliefs or practices in about sex, morality, or religion. 25

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, the following may survey high school students anonymously about their risk behavior associated with chronic health conditions, including those related to sexual health:

- (i) The state Department of Education.
- (ii) The Department of Health.

31(c) Prior to the administration of any survey authorized by the provisions32of Subparagraph (b) of this Paragraph, a student's parent or legal guardian33shall be provided the opportunity to request that the student be excused from34completing the survey. Upon such request, the student shall neither be given nor35be required to complete the survey.36\* \* \* \*
