- 12 "§793. Additional powers of the commissioner A.

 - (3)(a) The commissioner shall also provide by rule and regulation for the definition and issuance of a Class A-Caterers Permit for any person who does not otherwise qualify for a retail dealers permit pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 26:71.1 or R.S. 26:271.2. Any person holding a Class A-Caterers Permit shall not be authorized to sell alcoholic beverages to any wholesale or retail dealer licensed in accordance with this Title. The fees for a Class A-Caterers permit shall not exceed the fees for a Class A-Restaurant Permit set forth in R.S. 26:71(A).
 - (b) The regulations promulgated pursuant to this Paragraph shall authorize a third party who has entered into a written agreement with a retail dealer permitted to sell alcoholic beverages in manufacturer sealed containers for off-premise consumption to obtain a Class A-Caterers Permit. Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the Class A-Caterers Permit holder shall be authorized to facilitate the sale of alcoholic beverages for delivery to consumers from the retail dealer's licensed premises via the use of an internet-enabled platform and the Class A-Caterers permit holder or its employees or independent contractors shall be authorized to deliver alcoholic beverages to consumers on behalf of the retail dealer.
