TAX/HOTEL OCCUPANCY INCREASE LF RV See Note
Authorizes the governing authority of St. Bernard Parish to levy a hotel occupancy tax
Purpose of Bill: This bill allows the St. Bernard Parish Government to levy a hotel occupancy tax not to exceed $\$ 3$ per room per night. The tax proceeds are required to be used to provide fire protection services within the parish. This measure also provides that the tax be approved by the voters of the Parish, and be imposed by a Parish ordinance.

## EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

## This bill may increase local fund expenditures by an indeterminable amount.

An official with the St. Bernard Parish Government indicated that the tax revenue generated by this bill is not expected to be spent during the next five years as the Parish plans to replenish the St. Bernard Parish Fire Department's fund balance. In addition, this official expects that the St. Bernard Parish Sheriff's Office will collect the tax and charge the Parish $8 \%$ of collections as a fee.

An official with the Louisiana Secretary of State's Office indicated that the total election cost to the Parish could vary depending on when the election is held. Based on the recent costs of elections in the Parish, the total cost for the election would be about $\$ 46,000$ if held in the fall of 2019 or $\$ 34,000$ if held in the following spring. If the election is held on a statewide election date, the Parish would be responsible for paying no more than $25 \%$ of the total cost ( $\$ 46,000 \times .25=$ $\$ 11,500$ ). If the election is held at the same time as the spring municipal elections, the Parish would be responsible for paying the total cost of $\$ 34,000$. This official concluded that actual cost cannot be determined until the election is held and all costs are known.

## REVENUE EXPLANATION

This bill may increase local fund revenue by an indeterminable amount.
An official with the St. Bernard Parish Government indicated that this bill would increase Parish revenue, but that the amount of the increase was indeterminable because occupancy rate of the 251 hotel rooms within the Parish was unknown. However, in order to provide information about the potential revenue increase, this official provided the following revenue increases at various levels of occupancy rates:
$50 \%$ occupancy rate $=\$ 137,000$ ( 251 rooms $\times 365$ days $\times 50 \%$ occupancy rate $\times \$ 3$ )
$60 \%$ occupancy rate $=\$ 165,000$ ( 251 rooms $\times 365$ days $\times 60 \%$ occupancy rate $\times \$ 3$ )
$65 \%$ occupancy rate $=\$ 179,000$ ( 251 rooms $\times 365$ days $\times 65 \%$ occupancy rate $\times \$ 3$ )
$70 \%$ occupancy rate $=\$ 192,000$ ( 251 rooms $\times 365$ days $\times 70 \%$ occupancy rate $\times \$ 3$ )
$100 \%$ occupancy rate $=\$ 275,000$ ( 251 rooms $\times 365$ days $\times 100 \%$ occupancy rate $\times \$ 3$ )
