ELDERLY: Requests a study concerning prevention of elder abuse

Synopsis of Senate Amendments In the title of the Resolution, adds the office of financial institutions and the La. Bankers Association as entities called upon to collaborate in the study requested by the Resolution. Adds findings relative to the expertise of the office of financial institutions and the La. Bankers Association.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Authorizes and requests the governor's office of elderly affairs, the office of aging and adult services of the La. Department of Health, the office of financial institutions, the La. Bankers Association, and the legislative auditor, jointly, to study means by which this state can reduce the incidence of elder abuse.

Requests that a report findings of the study be submitted to the House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice, the Senate Committee on Judiciary C, the legislative committees on health and welfare, and the Legislative Audit Advisory Council.
