**SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL**

1. Remove the transfer of certain property between the commissioner of administration, the secretary of DOTD, and the Louisiana Department of Health.
2. Add the authorization to transfer certain state property from DOTD to the town of Delhi.
3. Make technical changes.

**DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE**

SB 149 Reengrossed

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Present law provides a procedure for the sale of public lands.

Authorizes commissioner of administration and LDH to transfer certain property related to the Central Louisiana Hospital in Rapides Parish pursuant to present law.

Authorizes the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DOTD to transfer certain property in Rapides Parish to the town of Boyce.

Authorizes the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DCFS to transfer certain property in Jackson Parish to the Jackson Parish Police Jury.

Authorizes the commissioner of administration and the secretary of DOTD to transfer certain property to the town of Delhi.

Proposed law creates the Louisiana Department of Health's Facility Support Fund Number 2 and provides for the transfer, use, and investment of monies in the fund.

Requires that after subtracting costs incurred by the division of administration related to the sale of the Central Louisiana State Hospital properties, the proceeds of any sale be paid into the LDH Facility Support Fund Number 2 and dedicated to the planning, design, permits, improvements, repairs, equipment, restoration, renovation, or construction of the Central Louisiana State Hospital.

Effective August 1, 2019.
