ABORTION: (Constitutional Amendment) Stipulates that no provision of the constitution protects a right to abortion or requires the funding of abortion

Report rejects Senate amendments which would have:

1. Added language relative to the purpose and intent of the constitutional amendment.

Report amends the bill to:

1. Change the election date <u>from Oct. 12, 2019 to Nov. 3, 2020.</u>

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides that, to protect human life, nothing in <u>present constitution</u> shall be construed to secure or protect a right to abortion or require the funding of abortion.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 3, 2020.
