SCHOOLS/BOARDS: Provides relative to the maximum and minimum size of school boards in certain parishes

## Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Requires a school board in a parish with a population of between 90,000 and 100,000 persons to reestablish itself with not less than five nor more than nine members.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law authorizes a school board, during the reapportionment process, to reestablish its membership with at least five but not more than 15 members. Provides that when the size of a school board is to be changed by reapportionment, the school board may submit the proposition of size to the people.

Proposed law requires a school board in a parish with a population of between 90,000 and 100,000 persons, by majority vote, to reestablish itself with not less than five nor more than nine members. Further adds that when the size of a school board is to be changed by reapportionment, the school board may submit the proposition of size to the people. Otherwise retains present law.
