## ACT 231 (HB 452) 2019 Regular Session

Existing law provides for the designation of controlled dangerous substances into Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V based upon the substances' potential for addiction and abuse.

<u>New law</u> adds nine substances (including Mitragynine) to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law, the schedule to which the substances will be added is dependent upon the classification of the substances as a controlled dangerous substance by the Drug Enforcement Administration of the U.S.

<u>Prior law</u> provided for the crime of unlawful distribution of products containing Mitragyna speciosa to a minor.

New law repeals prior law.

Effective if and when the Drug Enforcement Administration of the U.S. classifies Mitragyna as a controlled dangerous substance.
