Existing law, applicable to police officers employed at a rank of captain or below in municipalities with a population of between 12,000 and 250,000, provides that such officers shall receive overtime pay for each hour worked over 40 hours in a week. Authorizes such municipalities, including Houma specifically, to implement a 14-day cycle of 12-hour shifts and requires that the officers receive overtime pay or compensatory time when the number of hours worked exceeds 80 hours in a two-week period.

New law makes existing law relative to 14-day cycles for Houma police officers applicable to police dispatchers employed by the Houma police department.

Effective August 1, 2019.
