

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 252 (HB 593)**

**2019 Regular Session**

**Cox**

Existing law provides that the La. Real Estate Appraisers Board is authorized to collect an assessment of not more than \$1,500 for an application for an initial or renewal license. The board is also authorized to collect a delinquent renewal assessment and to prorate any assessment collected for an initial license issued after Jan. 1 of any year.

Prior law imposed an expiration date on existing law procedures relative to an applicant for license or a licensee applying for a renewal of his appraisal management company license. New law changes the sunset date in prior law from Dec. 31, 2019 to Dec. 31, 2022.

Effective August 1, 2019.
