<u>New law</u> requires any health benefit plan delivered or issued for delivery in this state to include coverage for the cost of testing of the BRCA1 and BRCA2 genes to detect an increased risk for breast and ovarian cancer when recommended by a healthcare provider in accordance with the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force recommendations for testing.

The coverage required by <u>new law</u> may be subject to annual deductibles, coinsurance, and copayment provisions as are consistent with those established under the health coverage plan.

New law defines "health coverage plan".

<u>New law</u> applies to any new policy, contract, program, or health coverage plan issued on and after Jan. 1, 2020. Any policy, contract, or health coverage plan in effect prior to Jan. 1, 2020, shall convert to conform to the provisions of <u>new law</u> on or before the renewal date, but no later than Jan. 1, 2021.

Effective January 1, 2020.
