Abstract: Repeals provisions providing for the automatic expiration of requirements for reports by executive branch agencies.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 49:1401) provides that a legislative mandate for an executive branch agency to produce a report expires five years after legislative approval of the mandate. Requires the producing agency to notify the legislature of the impending expiration. Authorizes the legislative committees with jurisdiction over the producing agency to extend the mandate for an additional five years. Provides for the first reports to expire July 1, 2019.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
