**Abstract:** Eliminates the mandatory retirement age requirement for all judges.

Present constitution requires that no judge may remain in office beyond his 70th birthday, but allows a judge to complete the current term if he attains 70 years of age while in office.

Proposed constitutional amendment repeals the mandatory retirement age of judges.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Nov. 3, 2020.
