Abstract: Removes requirement that registrars of voters file oaths of office with the treasurer; requires registrars of voters to file the required bonds with the secretary of state rather than the state treasurer.

Present law requires parish governing authorities to appoint a registrar of voters who is responsible for the registration of voters in the parish.

Present law requires registrars of voters to file oaths of office with the clerk of court, the secretary of state, and the state treasurer. Proposed law removes requirement that such oaths be filed with the treasurer.

Present law requires registrars of voters to file a bond for the faithful performance of duties with the state treasurer. Proposed law requires registrars to file this bond with the secretary of state.
