FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL: Provides relative to exemptions for steam heating boilers

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 23:540(B)(5), relative to regulations affecting boilers; to exempt
3 certain steam heating boilers; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 23:540(B)(5) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

6 §540. Exemptions from provisions

7 * * *

8 B. The provisions of this Part are not applicable to any of the following:

9 * * *

10 (5) Steam heating boilers carrying not more than fifteen pounds pressure
11 used exclusively for noncommercial purposes located in any private home.

Abstract: Exempts steam heating boilers carrying not more than 15 pounds pressure used exclusively for noncommercial purposes located in a private home.

Present law exempts certain boilers from regulations affecting boilers.

Proposed law retains present law and adds to the exemption for steam heating boilers carrying not more than 15 pounds pressure, the requirement that usage be exclusively for noncommercial purposes in a private home.
