HUNTING/PENALTIES: Repeals certain restrictions on the use of laser or infrared sights on guns while hunting

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 56:116.1(A)(8) and (B)(3)(a), relative to hunting; to repeal certain restrictions
3 on the use of laser or infrared sights on guns while hunting.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(A)(8) and (B)(3)(a) are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Abstract: Repeals certain restrictions on the use of laser or infrared sights on guns while hunting.

Present law restricts the use while hunting of a laser sight or sighting device with a beam of light to people with visual impairments who hold a physically challenged hunter permit. Such people are required to be accompanied by another licensed hunter.

Present law prohibits the use while hunting of an infrared sight, laser sight, or any sighting device with a beam of light to enhance vision at night.

Proposed law repeals both provisions of present law.
