**Abstract:** Adds appointments to the composition of the La. State Board of Nursing.

Present law provides that the La. State Board of Nursing shall be composed of eight registered nurses appointed by the governor from a list of names submitted by the La. State Nurses Association, one certified registered nurse anesthetist appointed by the governor from a list of names submitted by the La. Association of Nurse Anesthetists, Ltd., and two representatives of the consumers of Louisiana from the state at-large appointed by the governor, neither of whom shall be a nurse.

Proposed law revises the composition of the board by adding two registered nurses who shall be appointed by the governor from a list of names given by the La. Hospital Association.

Present law provides that the La. State Board of Nursing shall be composed of two members who are nursing service administrators; three members who are nurse educators, one of whom is a representative of an associate degree program in nursing, if such a representative applies to be and is submitted as a candidate for board membership in accordance with present law; three members who are in other areas of nursing practice, one of whom is an advanced practice registered nurse; and one certified registered nurse; and one certified registered nurse anesthetist. Further provides that there shall be two consumer members of the board as provided for in present law.

Proposed law increases the members who are in other areas of nursing practice from three to five. Further provides that one representative shall be from a rural hospital.
